IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Half hour lessons are conducted privately on a weekly basis. Music lesson fees also cover the student's ensemble involvement and tuition when they have reached an appropriate level as determined by their teacher.
- Each student is expected to receive one lesson each week of term with a minimum of eight lessons per Term. Lesson fees and hire charges where applicable will be charged to school accounts at the beginning of each Semester. If lessons commence after the beginning of a Semester a pro rata adjustment will apply. Lesson charges will be reconciled at the end of the Semester and adjusted accordingly. Music lessons are currently charged at the 2021 rate of \$53.00 per half hour. 2022 rates are yet to be confirmed.
- Students benefit greatly from performing experience and there is an expectation that students learning an instrument/voice through the School will be active members of School Ensembles/Choirs and participate in concerts and assemblies as required.
- Students are required to attend all scheduled lessons with their music, instrument and record book.
- One Month's notice (excluding school holidays) in writing is required to discontinue lessons. Charges will continue to apply until the end of the month. Please note charges still apply should your child take extended leave (unrelated to illness) during school Term.
- Students or parents must notify their instrumental teacher of absences due to excursions, tests or school events with at least 48 hours' notice of lessons. Failure to notify the teacher will result in the lessons being charged as usual.
