INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

We are proud of the education we provide our students at Peninsula Grammar and know that we build confident, accomplished and globally minded individuals. We are a community-minded school that values diversity, celebrates individuality and welcomes everyone

Our International Scholarship Program, for Vietnamese students, offers two types of Scholarship opportunities

 ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE for students with superior academic ability and wanting to achieve the highest of VCE attainment standards.

The Scholarship is for students with proven academic excellence and high-level English language proficiency and provides outstanding remission of two years tuition fees. The value of two years tuition is approximately A\$86,000.

2. GENERAL EXCELLENCE for students who have outstanding academic ability and all-round student excellence.

The Scholarship is for students with proven academic excellence and high-level English language proficiency and provides significant 50% remission of two years tuition fees. The value of two years tuition is approximately A\$86,000

These scholarships are normally for students currently in Year 10 studying at a Gifted High School in Vietnam: for a position in Years 11 and 12 in the Victorian Certificate of Education. Students in Year 11 will also be considered for a position in Year 12 in 2026 Students not attending schools for the Gifted may also be considered.

Students should have completed at least Year 10 in Vietnam before they begin to study in Australia in January 2026.

APPLICATION PROCESS



STAGE 1 – SHORT-LISTING FOR INTERVIEW

1. Scholarship application form with parent's signature

2. A copy of the three most recent school reports. These will need to be translated and certified as original. The required GPA is above 8.0 for gifted students and 8.5 for students from other schools

3. Merit Certificates

4. Relevant documents demonstrating strong English language proficiency, at least 6.0 overall and 5.5 in the writing section of IELTS or equivalent test (If at the time of initial application you have not completed IELTS and you are shortlisted for interview, you will be given until 15 August 2025 to complete your IELTS).

5. A handwritten letter from you as to why you would like to come to Australia to study and your future aspirations.

6. A Curriculum Vitae giving all personal details, contact email and phone numbers and a list of achievements beyond academia.

7. The name, position, telephone number and email address of a referee who is, or has been your teacher, or who holds a senior position in your school. Please make sure all above documents reach IDP Vietnam no later than 31 July 2025. Certified copies of original documents are required and documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations.

STAGE 2 – SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED

1. A recent digital photo.

2. A copy of the details page of your passport, or if you have no passport, your ID card.

3. An acceptance letter to the offer of the scholarship, signed by one of your parents.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SELECTION PROCESS

- Short-listed candidates will be contacted and invited to participate in an interview to be held in Vietnam
- Interviews will take place in early September in HCMC and Hanoi.
- The interview with each candidate will last about 30 minutes and be conducted in English.
- The interview will play a major role in the awarding of each Scholarship.
- If you are shortlisted and you do not have an IELTS score you will be given until August 15th 2024 to complete IELTS or its equivalent.

COSTS NOT INCLUDED

The following costs will be the responsibility of student's family in the case that the student accepts the scholarship and enrolls at Peninsula Grammar School:

- 1. Agent Visa Assistance: US\$500
- 2. Visa application fee for Australian Consulate General

3. Estimated living expenses: around A\$45,000/year (including accommodation, airfare fees, uniform and book charges)

APPLICATION NOTIFICATION

- All applicants will be advised of the outcome of their scholarship applications in late September 2025.
